The Organizing Committee is glad to invite you to participate in the International Figure Skating Competition **WOLMAR Spring Cup in Figure Skating**, held in Valmiera, Latvia, from April 7th -9th, 2023

1. GENERAL

WOLMAR Spring Cup 2023 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **WOLMAR Spring Cup 2023** is open to all Competitors who belong to LSA Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 in accordance with the ISU General Regulations 2022 or any update of this and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification. All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

Free Skating only Girls and Boys (2 min., +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements (one of which must be an Axel type jump).
- b) Maximum of two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any listed jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump.
- c) Maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (minimum of 4 revolutions each).
- d) One (1) step sequence.

**CHICKS A Girls and Boys
Born 2014/2015:**

Free Skating only 2 min., +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements (one of which must be an Axel type jump)
- b) Maximum of two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can (2) Jumps. - a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements minimum of two (2) jump elements
- b) Maximum of two (2) jump combinations. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps.
- c) Maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (minimum of 3 revolutions each);
NB!!! All spins must contain only Base positions. Difficult variations spins will be ignored by technical panel and will have not value.
- d) One (1) Choreo Sequence.

1 Axel and double (2) jumps are not allowed in Pre-chicks B category!

CHICKS B Girls and Boys Born 2014/2015:

Free Skating only 2 min., +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements
- b) Maximum of two (2) jump combinations. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps.
- c) Maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (minimum of 3 revolutions each)
- d) One (1) Choreo Sequence.

1 Axel and double (2) jumps are not allowed in Chicks B category!

**CUBS B Free Girls and Boys
Born 2012/2013:**

Skating only) 2 min. 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements.
- b) Maximum of two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any listed jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump.
- c) Maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (minimum of three (5) revolutions).
- d) One step sequence.

**1 Axel and one (1) double jump are allowed not more than two (2) times.
2Lo, 2F and 2Lz – are not allowed in this category**

**SPRINGS B Girls and Boys
Born 2010/2011:**

Free Skating only 2 min. 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements (one of which must be an Axel type jump).
- b) Maximum of two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any listed jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump.
- c) Maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (minimum of three (5) revolutions);
- d) One step sequence.

Maximum 2 (two) different double jumps are allowed and they cannot be repeated more than twice!

2A, 2F and 2Lz – are not allowed in this category!

 6. Falls - 0.5 point (Chiks B, Cubs B, Springs), 0,25 point (Pre-Chiks B) deduction for every fall 3
 7. Interruption
 - more than 10 sec. up to 20 sec.: -0,5
 - more than 20 sec. up to 30 sec.: -1,0
 - more than 30 sec. up to 40 sec.: - 1,5
- Interruption of the program with allowance of up to three (3) min. to resume from the point of interruption: -2.5 per program
8. Warm up group up to 10 skaters
 9. Warm up 4 min.

NOVICE B Girls and Boys

Age limits- has reached at least the age of ten (10) - has not reached the age of fifteen (15) before July 1st preceding the event.

Free Skating only 3 min. +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum five (5) jump elements - at least one (1) Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. A jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any listed jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature. One of which must be a spin combination with change of foot (minimum of eight (8) revolutions in total) or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) Flying entry is allowed. One spin with no change of position with change of foot (minimum of eight (8) revolutions in total) or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed
- c) One (1) Step sequence with full utilization of the ice surface. The sequence will receive a Level and will be evaluated in GOE.

Double Axel and triple jumps are not allowed!

JUNIOR B Women and Men

Born the same age as Junior A:

Free Skating only 3 min., +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of five (5) jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump;
- b) Maximum of three (3) jump combinations or sequences; (Only one jump combination may consist of three (3) jumps); A jump sequence consists of 2 (two)

jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any listed jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump.

- c) Three (3) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (minimum of ten (10) revolutions in total), one a flying spin (minimum of six (6) revolutions) and one spin is optional (minimum of six (6) revolutions).
- d) One (1) step sequence.

2A and triple jumps are not allowed!

SENIOR B Women and Men
Born the same age as Junior A:

Free Skating only 3.30 min., +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of six (6) jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump.
- b) Maximum of three (3) jump combinations or sequences (Only one jump combination may consist of three (3) jumps); A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any listed jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump 4.
- c) Three (3) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (minimum of ten (10) revolutions in total), one a flying spin (minimum of six (6) revolutions) and one spin is optional (minimum of six (6) revolutions).
- d) One (1) step sequence.

2A and triple jumps are not allowed!

- 3. No jump with the same name may be repeated more than twice including Axel type jumps.
- 4. There shall be no bonus for difficult elements in the second half of the program
- 5. Time violation - 0.5 point (Novice B) deduction for every 5 seconds in excess.
- 6. Falls - 0.5 point (Novice B) deduction for every fall
- 7. Interruption
 - more than 10 sec. up to 20 sec.: -0.5
 - more than 20 sec. up to 30 sec.: -1.0
 - more than 30 sec. up to 40 sec.: -1.5Interruption of the program with allowance of up to three (3) min. to resume from the point of interruption: -2.5 per program
- 8. Warm up group up to 8 skaters
- 9. Warm up 5 min.

**PRE-CHICKS C Girls and Boys
Born 2016 and younger:**

Free Skating only 2 min., +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements minimum of two (2) jump elements.
- b) Maximum of two (2) jump combinations. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps.
- c) Maximum of two (2) spins, each spin in one position (minimum of 3 revolutions each).
NB!!! All spins must contain only Base positions. Difficult variations spins will be ignored by technical panel and will have not value.
- d) One (1) Choreo Sequence. Waltz jump is allowed in Pre Chicks C category and has a value 0.20.

1 Axel, 1Lutz, 1Flip, 1Lo and double jumps are not allowed in pre-chicks C category!

**CHICKS C Girls and Boys
Born 2014/2015:**

Free Skating only) 2 min., +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements.
- b) Maximum of two (2) jump combinations. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps.
- c) Maximum of two (2) spins, each spin in one position (minimum of 3 revolutions each);
NB!!! All spins must contain only Base positions. Difficult variations spins will be ignored by technical panel and will have not value.
- d) One (1) Choreo Sequence. Waltz jump is allowed in Chicks C category and has a value 0.20

Free Skating only 2 min., +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements.
- b) Maximum of two (2) jump combinations. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps.
- c) Maximum of two (2) spins, each spin in one position (minimum of 3 revolutions each);

NB!!! All spins must contain only Base positions. Difficult variations spins will be ignored by technical panel and will have not value.

d) One (1) Choreo Sequence 5

1. In all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to Level Base will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.
2. Evaluation is in accordance with ISU Communication No. 2474 (or any update of this Communication).
3. No jump with the same name may be repeated more than twice including Axel type jumps.
4. There shall be no bonus for difficult elements in the second half of the program
5. Time violation - 0.5 point deduction for every 5 seconds in excess
6. Falls - 0.25 point deduction for every fall
7. Interruption – 0.5
8. Warm up group up to 10 skaters

BEGINNERS Girls and Boys

Born 2010-2012:

Free Program: max. 2:00 min +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum four (4) jump elements- at least two (2) of them are solo jumps - at least one (1) and no more than two (2) are jump combinations. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps.
- b) Maximum of two (2) spins, each spin in one position (minimum of 3 revolutions each).

NB!!! All spins must contain only Base positions. Difficult variations spins will be ignored by technical panel and will have not value.

c) One (1) Choreo Sequence

Axel and double jumps are not allowed!

BEGINNERS Girls and Boys

Born 2008 -2010 and 2005-2007:

Free Program: max. 2:30 min +/- 10 sec.

1. Maximum five (4) jump elements
 - at least two (2) of them are solo jumps
 - at least one (1) and no more than two (2) are jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any listed jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump.
2. At least one (1) but not more than two (2) spins of a different nature min. four (4) revolutions.

3. Step sequence (2/3 cover of the ice), (straight line, circular or serpentine).

Maximum one (1) Axel and one (1) double jump are allowed!

IMPORTANT!!!

1. In all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to Level Base will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.
2. Evaluation is in accordance with ISU Communication No. 2474 (or any update of this Communication).
3. No jump with the same name may be repeated more than twice including Axel type jumps.
4. There shall be no bonus for difficult elements in the second half of the program.
5. Time violation - 0.5 point deduction for every 5 seconds in excess.
6. Falls - • 0.5 point deduction for every fall.
7. Interruption – 0.5
8. Warm up group up to 10 skaters.
9. Warm up 4 min.

4. ENTRIES FOR COMPETITION

All the members of ISU and Clubs, being members of National Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part in this competition.

Members can enter any quantity of Skaters/Couples into each category.

5. ENTRIES

5.1. ENTRY FEE:

Single Skating – 90 Eur

Single Skating 1 (one) program – 75 Eur

5.2. ENTRY FEE PAYMENT:

Entry fees must be paid after confirmation of member participation. Bill must be paid with one (1) transaction for all the country/member participants. The Organizer

will not return entry fee but you can replace one skater for another in the same category only and not later than one week before draw.

6. OFFICIALS

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) Judge with the qualification “Judge for International competitions” or “ISU Judge” per discipline, double duty Judges are very welcome. The Panels of Judges will consist of a minimum of five (5) Judges in all panels.

The Referees and the Technical Panel members will be invited by the Organizing Committee. In case of too many nominated Judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

7. EXPENSES

Competitors and all other Team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

8. LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the WOLMAR Spring Cup 2023, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

Please note – livestream video and photography is provided during all the event.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the event mentioned above.

9. THE CODE OF ETHICS

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU Communication 2342, (or any update of this Communication). Action against this rule conducts by itself the disqualification of the skater.

10. MUSIC

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations Technical Rules Single Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- The participating member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (latviatrophie@gmail.com) **until March 24th, 2023.**

Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

- Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s).

Example: LAT_Junior_Men_FS_BERZINS Janis
LAT_Senior_Women_SP_OZOLA Liga

- The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.
- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
- During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and will allow to verify the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (USB Stick with file format of WAV or MP3 file).

11. PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENTS

With the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee. (wolmar@gmail.com) it is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be completed precisely by each skater/couple in English using the proper terminology.

12. AWARDS

The top three competitors in each event (Final results) will be honored and awarded by Trophies, special presents and diplomas.

The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time.

13. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.
