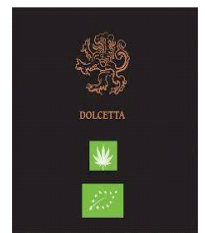

ANNOUNCEMENT / INVITATION

WELCOME

The Organizing Committee are glad to invite you and your club to participate in the Volvo Open Cup 51st International Competition.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Volvo Open Cup 51st** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Volvo Open Cup 51st** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation. Clubs registered at ISU Members Federations can participate in competition or Invited clubs ONLY. The OC can have a final design about over quota for any club/country/federation or refuse to accept the entry (full or partially).

Members can enter any quantity of Skaters into each category.

ENTRY FEE

90 EUR per skater (Advanced Novice)

75 EUR per skater (Interclub)

Late Entry Fee: 105 EUR per skater

Late Entry Fee: 90 EUR per skater

Notice: All Entry Fee payments recieved after December 26th, 2023 are subject to late entry fee of 15€ per single skater. The late entry fee is not applicable only if a Member Federation or Club is substituting a skater, whose entry fee was paid by the deadline by another skater.

ENTRY FEE PAYMENT

Entry fees must be paid after confirmation of member participation. Bill must be paid with one (1) transaction for all the country/member participants.

The entry fee will not be refunded after the deadline in case of withdrawals for any reason.

APPOINTED EVENT OFFICIALS / ENTRTIES OF JUDGES

This Volvo Open Cup 51st. event will follow the principles of International Skating Union for appointing the event officials. The members of each individual Technical Panel, Referee and Judges will have at least the qualification "International".

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) Judge with the qualification "Judge for International competitions" or "ISU Judge" per discipline, double duty Judges are very welcome. We cover hotel`s/meal/pocket money ONLY for Judges who are acting in several panels except those where own federation skaters are presented

In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

PRACTISE

You have book in advanced till 04.01.2024. Extra fee: 25.- Euro / 25 min. person, no music. The detailed schedule will be issued at the time of registration

MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENTS

All competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on USB flash drive
The music files must be sent as MP3, M4A or WAV format. Any other format is not acceptable.
In accordance with Rule 343 paragraph 2. USB must have Competitor`s name, Member`s name and the exact running time of the Music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration.

Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) in the format of a MP3, M4A or WAV format.

If music information is not complete and music not provided, accreditation will not be given.

With the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee. (Kristal_ice@hello.lv), It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be completed precisely by each skater/couple in English using the proper terminology.

DRAW

Electronic draw will be done for all the categories (except Senior and Junior categories). Starting orders for the second segment FS will be reverse order of the result of SP.

EXPENSES

Competitors

Competitors and all other Team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

The nearest airport is Riga International Airport (RIX) with a distance of 8 km to the official hotel and 7 km to the venue.

In accordance with the ISU Directive please note that at the time of registration (Entry fee, music) we

have to copy and file the passport of the Skaters (in case you happen to bring it with you or send it by e-mail beforehand it will make us very happy).

RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used. Result information and detailed protocols will be available on the website: <http://kristalice.lv>

AWARDS

The top three competitors in each event (Final results) will be honored and awarded by Trophies, special presents and diplomas; others will receive memory presents. The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time. Please make sure that all skaters are represented at the Ceremony.

INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Volvo Open Cup 51st, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the event mentioned above.

THE CODE OF ETHICS

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU Communication 2478, (or any update of this Communication). Action against this rule conducts by itself the disqualification of the skater.
